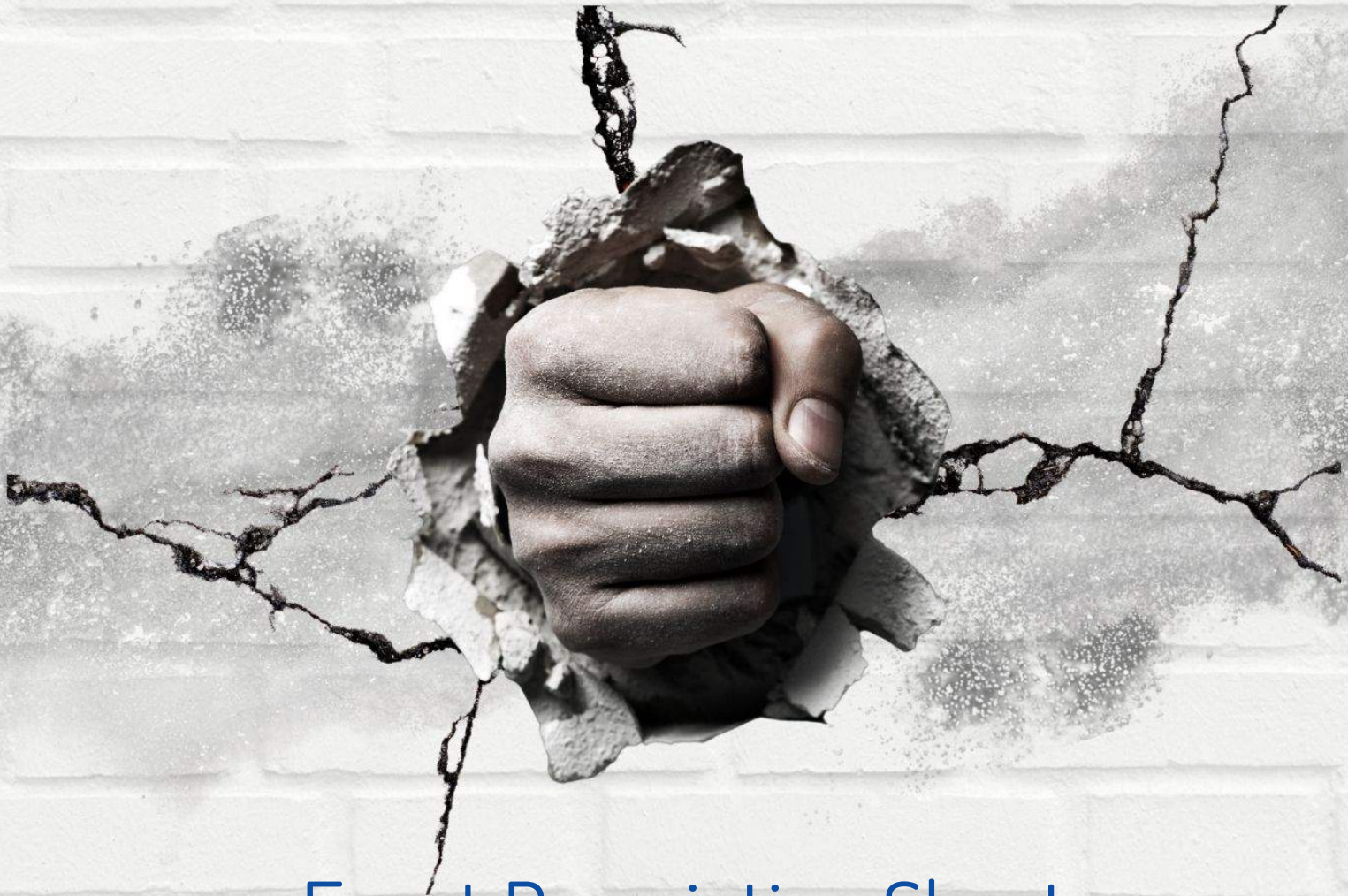

Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

D1.1-D5.1 The first training/workshop “EU for all!” on EU institutions and opportunities in Croatia involved 80 participants (73 young people, 7 adults), consisting of 2-day sessions(1 day training + 1 day workshop) on May 4th and 5th 2023.

During two days of education, topics such as: How the European Union functions; Opportunities for young people in the European Union; Elections for the EU Parliament in 2024; EU values were covered in a dynamic and interactive manner. The training was led by FFE experts Maja Šarić and Eli Pijaca Plavšić, and colleagues from the National Agency for Mobility and EU Programs joined as guest lecturers. Through workshops, interactive lectures and activities, students showed a high motivation for learning about topics related to the European Union, a desire for social engagement and active participation in the community, as well as a desire to participate in the many opportunities offered to them through various EU programs. Through anonymous evaluation questionnaires, students expressed their satisfaction with the education (the average rating on a scale from 1 to 5 was 4.26). They rated very highly the impact that this education had on improving their knowledge of the EU (4.07), as well as encouraging them to participate in the elections for the European Parliament in 2024 (3,92). The trainers competences were also highly rated (4,74). Almost 90% of students who participated at the workshop would like to be involved in the further activities of the EUNITE project.

The training was held in cooperation with the Liaison Office of the European Parliament in Croatia and was organised in their premises.

The workshop was covered in media – Croatian national radio station (1st channel) covered the workshop in the radio broadcast "Always the first - education and science" on May 10th 2023 (30 minutes lenght).

D1.1-D5.1 The second training/workshop “EU for all!” on EU institutions and opportunities in Croatia involved 13 participants (adults), consisting of 1 full-day sessions(1/2 day training + 1/2 day workshop) on June 16th 2023. The training was held in permises of FFE.

During one days of education, topics such as: How the European Union functions; Elections for the EU Parliament in 2024; EU values were covered in a dynamic and interactive manner. The training was led by FFE experts Maja Šarić and Eli Pijaca Plavšić. Through workshops, interactive lectures and activities, parzicipants showed a high motivation for learning about topics related to the European Union and interest in EU elections topics.

Through anonymous evaluation questionnaires, participnats expressed their satisfaction with the education (the average rating on a scale from 1 to 5 was 4.85). They rated very highly the impact that this education had on improving their knowledge of the EU (4.73), as well as encouraging them to participate in the elections for the European Parliament in 2024 (4,84). The trainers competences were also highly

rated (4,77). 100% of participants who participated at the workshop would like to be involved in the further activities of the EUNITE project.
